- 1938 Born Miaoli, Taiwan
- 1953-1957 Apprenticed to a Buddhist statuary craftsman, Lee Chin-chuan
- 1966 Awarded the prize of excellence for sculpture at 21st Taiwan Art Exhibition
- 1967 Awarded third prize for sculpture at the 22nd Taiwan Art Exhibition
- 1968-1976 Studied modern sculpture with Yuyu Yang (1926-1997), who was considered Taiwan's leading modern sculptor
- 1976 Won Arts Award from the Chinese Cultural and Arts Association
- 1977 First international exhibit, Tokyo's Central Museum
- 1981 Studies in New York, develops the Living World Series
- 1989 Commissioned by the Chinese government to create a monumental Tai-chi figure for the Bank of China, Hong Kong
- 1998 Received the Fok Yin Tung Award, Hong Kong
- 1999 The Ju Ming Museum, a project begun in 1987, opens in Taipei, Taiwan
- 2000 The Ju Ming Museum wins the 14th Tokyo Creative Award, Foreign Award
- 2002 Won the Yuan Kong Award in Yokoso, Japan
- 2003 Awarded Honorary Degree of Doctor of Art, Fu Jen Catholic University, Taipei, Taiwan
- 2004 Won the Executive Yuan Cultural Award, 2004, Taiwan
